Design a set of class rules for Otters. Try to make them positive e.g. Always remember to put your hand up. Only use kind words. (rather than Don't.....)



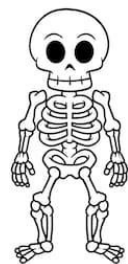
Suggestion 2
