Theme: Once Upon a Time (The Little Red Hen)

For the next two weeks we will be exploring the story "The Little Red Hen".

Activities 1. Talk about the story with your child.

Who were the characters in the story?

What did the Little Red Hen plant?

How did she make her seed grow?

Did the other animals help the little Red Hen?

What did the little Red Hen make at the end?

Did the little Red Hen share?

What was your favourite part of the story?

2. Ask your child to draw or paint a picture from the story, their favourite character or part of the story. Encourage your child to draw basic shapes like a circle and these can be used to represent things.

3. Make some plaincoloured playdough and the children can pretend to knead and fold and make bread with.

4. Have a go at making your own character masks that your child can use to role play the story.
