6. What can you play in the snow.

Activities: Literacy

Can you draw a picture from the story and write a simple sentence to go with it. For example:

The hedgehog (hejhog) went to get Badger (Baju).

Please do not tell the children how to spell the words - they will be able to sound these out. Encourage your child to use the sounds they can hear when writing.

Can you use whatever materials you have at home to build a nest?

Count how many animals Hedgehog saw on his journey.
